

NOTICE OF RACE

RCYC Crawdad Cup Regatta

April 5, 2014

1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

1.2 The class rules of applicable national authorities will apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The regatta is open to all sailboats. Three one-design boats will constitute a class.

2.2 Eligible boats may enter by checking in with the race committee by 11:50am on Saturday, April 5, 2014 or online at rcyc.org.

3. FEES. Entry for the regatta is \$0.

4. SCHEDULE

4.1 Registration: Saturday, April 5, 2014 from 10:00am to 11:00am in the RCYC Clubhouse at the bar.

4.2 Competitors Briefing on Saturday, April 5, 2014 from 11:00am in the RCYC Bar.

4.3 As many races as possible will be attempted before 4pm, weather permitting. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 12:00pm

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS. The sailing instructions will be available after 10:30am on Saturday, April 5, 2014 from 10:00am in the RCYC Bar.

6. VENUE. The racing area will be the Lake Ray Hubbard, South of Interstate 30.

7. THE COURSES. The courses to be sailed will be communicated at the competitor meeting. A weather mark for keelboats and a weather mark for dinghys will be set.

8. SCORING

8.1 The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply.

8.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

8.3 There will be no throwouts. This changes rule A2.

9. RADIO COMMUNICATION.

9.1 A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

9.2 The race committee will attempt to hail premature starters via VHF channel 72.

10. PRIZES. Prizes will be awarded for each class.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12. INSURANCE. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
