NOTICE of RACE

HEATH, TEXAS

2017 Crawdad Cup April 8th, 2017

1. RULES The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. The class rules of applicable national authorities will apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The regatta is open to all sailboats. Four one-design boats will constitute a class.

2.2 Eligible boats may enter online at rcyc.org or by checking-in at Registration. (Early registration is encouraged so we will know how many bags of Crawdads to purchase!)

3. FEES. Entry for the regatta is \$20. Fee includes one (1) dinner wristband. Additional dinner wristbands can be purchased at the registration desk for \$10 each.

4. SCHEDULE

- 10:00 – 12:00PM Registration in the RCYC Clubhouse bar.
- 12:00PM - Competitors Briefing on the RCYC Deck.
- 1:00PM - First warning signal is 1:00pm.

5 VENUE. The racing area will be the Lake Ray Hubbard, South of Interstate 30.

6. THE COURSE(S).

6.1 The course(s) to be sailed will be communicated at the Competitors Briefing. Expect one large tour of the lake race.

6.2 Alternate or additional courses may be set depending on weather and/or fleet vote.

6.3 No race will be started after 3PM.

7. CLASSES. The fleet may be divided into designated classes at the discretion of the Race Committee.

8. SCORING

8.1 The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply.

8.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

8.3 There will be no throwouts. This changes rule A2.

9. RADIO COMMUNICATION.

9.1 A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

9.2 The race committee will attempt to hail premature starters via VHF channel 72.

10. PRIZES. Prizes will be awarded for each class.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
