1. RULES

- a. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (2017-2020).
- b. The RCYC Go/No Go Chart will be used at the discretion of the Race Committee.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND REGISTRATION

- a. All centerboard boats. Expected classes are MC Scow, Sunfish, Flying Scot and Portsmouth.
- b. A minimum of four yachts of the same design will constitute a one-design class.
- c. Boats may enter using the on-line entry form on the RCYC website.

3. FEES

- a. Entry Fee is \$25.00 (includes donuts and Sat post-race beer; lunches are **not** included and may be purchased for \$10.00 each).

4. SCHEDULE

- a. **Saturday October 5, 2019, 9:00 am**, Registration opens
- b. **Saturday October 5, 2019, 10:30 am**, Competitor's briefing at RCYC
- c. **Saturday October 5, 2019, 12:30 pm**, First Warning signal
- d. **Saturday, October 5, 2019, Post-Race Fun**, Keg beer at the RCYC clubhouse
- e. **Sunday, October 6, 2019, 10:00 am**, No warning signal shall be made after 1 pm
- f. **Sunday, October 6, 2019**, Awards will be presented approximately 1 hour after the last committee boat enters the harbor. In the event of a protest, the class(es) of the protesting party(ies) may receive awards after the protest hearing. Results for the fleet may not wait for the protest results.

5. MEASUREMENTS

- a. One Design classes will comply with all requirements of the relevant class association.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- a. The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board "Official Notice Board" located in on the west facing window at the south end of the RCYC Clubhouse.

7. VENUE

- a. All races will be sailed on Lake Ray Hubbard.

8. SCORING

- a. A single race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- b. The low-point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply. At least six races for a class must be completed for a race to be excluded. This modifies RRS Appendix A.

10. PRIZES

- a. Trophies will be awarded based on the number of registrants per class.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- a. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
