

NOTICE OF RACE
Rush Creek Yacht Club Winter Series
November 24, 2012 through January 26, 2012

1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

1.2 Any racing started in the calendar year 2012 will be governed by the 2009 – 2012 Racing Rules of Sailing.

1.3 Any racing started in the calendar year 2013 will be governed by the 2013 – 2016 Racing Rules of Sailing.

1.4 The class rules of applicable national authorities will apply.

2 ADVERTISING. Category C advertising applies.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The race series is open to all boats with a PHRF rating.

3.2 Boats with a Portsmouth rating will need to convert that rating to a PHRF number.

4 SCHEDULE

4.1 Registration: Check-in with Race committee before start

4.2 Any RCYC planned event or regatta can supersede scheduled race dates.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS. The sailing instructions will be available on the RCYC web site before November 24, 2012.

6 VENUE. The racing area will be the southern end on Lake Ray Hubbard, Heath Texas

7 THE COURSES. The courses to be sailed will be defined in the sailing instructions.

8 SCORING

8.1 The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply using .

8.2 Six races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

8.3 There will be two races eligible for throw-out. This changes rule A2.

8.4 The Commodores Requiem a RCYC sanction regatta held will be included in the scoring of the winter series scoring.

9 NO HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS Apply. All boats can be hauled out during the series.

10 RADIO COMMUNICATION.

10.1 A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats.

10.2 The race committee will attempt to hail premature starters via VHF.

11 INSURANCE. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance. Proof of insurance may be requested.

13 PRIZES. Prizes will be awarded for each class.

14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
