SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. SCHEDULE OF RACES.

Number of Races Scheduled – as many as possible.

Time of First Warning Signal – 1000.

Latest Time for a Warning Signal – 1600.

2. LOCATION OF RACE OFFICE AND FLAG POLE.

The “flag pole” as referenced in APPENDIX S – STANDARD SAILING INSTRUCTIONS is the mast on the west lawn of the Club. The “race office” is the Club office.

3. LIST AND DESCRIPTION OF MARKS. The marks are:

A. The starting mark will be a red or orange round buoy (a “hippity hop”).

B. The rounding marks will be orange tetrahedrons. Change marks will be yellow tetrahedrons.

C. The finishing mark will be a red or orange round buoy.

4. TIME LIMITS. For each race, the time limits are:

Mark 1 Time Limit

Race Time Limit

Finishing Window

20 minutes

1 hour

10 minutes

5. CHANGES TO APPENDIX S – STANDARD SAILING INSTRUCTIONS.

The changes to RRS APPENDIX S – STANDARD SAILING INSTRUCTIONS are:

A. Class Flags. The class flags for starting will be the class flag for each individual one-design class and the numeral pennant “3” for the Portsmouth class.

B. Starting System. APPENDIX U – AUDIBLE-SIGNAL RACING SYSTEM will apply instead of RRS 26. This changes STANDARD SAILING INSTRUCTION 9.1.

C. Sequence of Class Starts. If there is a sufficient number of boats entered to constitute each class, the initial order of starts will be:

1st. VX EVO

2nd. Flying Scot.

3rd. MC Scow.

4th. Sunfish.

5th. Laser

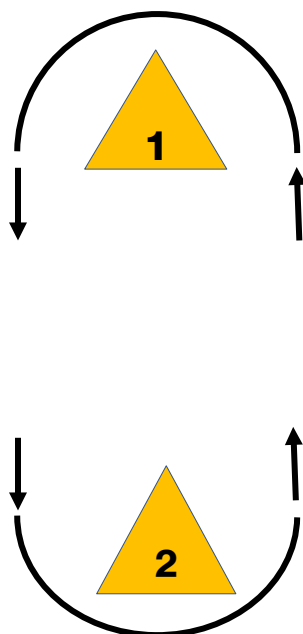
6th Portsmouth.

The Race Committee will endeavor to follow the original order but may change it. The Race Committee will indicate the next class by manually waving the class flag of the next class to start during the audible Attention signal; the warning signal for that class will be less than 1 minute after the Attention signal. This changes RRS U1.

- D. General Recall. After a general recall, the recalled class will move to the end of the order for starts or as signaled by the Race Committee. This changes RRS 29.2.
- E. Course Descriptions. The course description for each race for each class will be displayed on the Signal Boat. Course W in the STANDARD SAILING INSTRUCTIONS is replaced with COURSES W DIAGRAM.
- F. Finish. The finish line is a between a staff with a blue flag on the Signal Boat and the nearby finishing mark. This changes STANDARD SAILING INSTRUCTION 11.1.
- G. Postponement Ashore. When code flag AP is displayed ashore, “1 minute” is replaced with “not less than 30 minutes” in RRS RACE SIGNALS. This changes STANDARD SAILING INSTRUCTION 4.2.
- H. Postponement, Abandonment Signals Without Sound. The Race Committee may display code flags AP over A or H and N over A or H without its corresponding sound signal. This changes RRS RACE SIGNALS.
